

## COMMUNIQUE

### ***SUBMISSION OF DECLARATION OF ASSETS***

#### ***(Section 14 of MRA Act)***

The Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) is an agent of the State under the MRA Act 2004 for the management, operation and administration of Revenue laws. It is a body corporate administered by a Revenue Board and became fully operational with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2006.

As part of its recruitment policy and in accordance with MRA Act, the MRA requires that applicants for posts advertised submit a Declarations of Assets duly sworn / solemnly affirmed in the Supreme Court of Mauritius. In order to facilitate this process, the MRA wishes to inform the public that the Supreme Court of Mauritius has made necessary arrangements for Declaration of Assets to be sworn at **any** court of justice or district court nearest to the residence of applicants.

All Court Managers posted at District Courts have already been authorised by the Honourable Chief Justice of the Supreme Court to act as Commissioner of Oath.
