

COMMUNIQUE

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

The Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) regularly carries out public auctions in its Custom's headquarters at Mer Rouge, Rodrigues and elsewhere. Sworn Auctioneers are hereby invited to submit a brief describing their professional profile, their experience in holding public auctions and the modalities of their operation for MRA's consideration.

The following documents/information with suitable verifiable evidence shall be supplied as part of brief:

- Sworn Auctioneer profile and the profiles of key staff who will be carrying out the auctions
- Evidence of registration/certification as a Sworn Auctioneer
- Contact person and addresses including email address, if available
- Other information to assist MRA in the evaluation of the capability of the Sworn Auctioneer

In addition parties applying should:

- not have been subjected to disqualification or debarment by the Procurement Policy Office; and
- not have been convicted of any offence involving fraud or corruption; and
- not have its business activities suspended; and
- have fulfilled the obligations to pay taxes and social security contributions, where applicable

Sealed envelope of the Expression of Interest should be deposited in the Tender Box at the seat of the Mauritius Revenue Authority, Finance and Administration Department, Level 8, Eham Court, Cnr Mgr Gonin & Sir Virgil Naz Streets Port Louis by 30 June 2012. Expression of interest received after that date will be rejected and will not be considered. Participation in the expression of interest is not a precondition for selection in Auctions organised by the MRA. Expression of Interest is not transferable.
