SALE BY PUBLIC TENDER OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, MOTOR VEHICLES, ALCOHOL BEVERAGES, GENERAL GOODS Etc.

1. Bids on appropriate forms are invited from members of the public including traders, dealers, companies, etc, for the sale on an 'AS IS WHERE IS' basis of above mentioned items.
2. **The goods may be viewed at the MRA-Customs Auction Sales Warehouse, Lux Shed, Mer Rouge as from Tuesday 06 March 2012 to Tuesday 13 March 2012 (working days only) from 10.00 hrs to 15.00 hrs; Saturday 10 March 2012 from 09.30 hrs to 12.00 hrs closing Tuesday 13 March 2012 from 10.00 hrs to 13.00 hrs.**
3. The list of items can be viewed on the Mauritius Revenue Authority's website: <http://www.mra.mu> as from Tuesday 06 March 2012.
4. The Bid Form may be downloaded from the Mauritius Revenue Authority's website or collected from the Counter at the ground floor, Custom House, Mer Rouge, Port Louis and also from the MRA-Customs Auction Sales Warehouse at Lux Shed, Mer Rouge as from Tuesday 06 March 2012.
5. Tenders duly filled should be addressed in sealed envelopes marked "Tender Quotation 01 of 2012" and deposited in the Tender Box at the Registry Section, Custom House, Mer Rouge, Port Louis or at the MRA-Customs Auction Sales Warehouse, Lux Shed, Mer Rouge by 13.00 hrs on Tuesday 13 March 2012.
6. **Offers should be open and remain valid for acceptance for a period of two months with effect from the closing date. All bids on items No.01 and 27 require a deposit of 10% of the tender offer and a deposit of Rs 10,000 is required for Bids on Item 28 whereby offer will be allowed only to bidders possessing an export licence . Deposits should be by way of banker's cheque drawn in favour of DIRECTOR GENERAL, MRA.**
7. Offers received after the prescribed date and time shall not be considered.
8. Bidders may bid in any quantity indicating the quoted price per unit.
9. Successful bidders shall effect payment and take delivery of ALL ITEMS AWARDED within 10 days as from the date of the letter of award , failing which the offer will lapse. Selected bidders for item 28 should seek approval from Ministry of Local government prior to exportation. Payment can only be effected either in cash or Office Bank Cheque drawn in favour of Director General MRA.
10. The MRA reserves the right:
 - a. To accept or reject any bid, or
 - b. To annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to the award of the tender without thereby incurring any liability or any obligation to inform any bidder of the grounds for accepting or rejecting any bid.
11. Bidders are not allowed to bid for the same items more than once.
12. Tenders with erasures / written with lead pencils/without signature shall be rejected.
13. Mandatory fields on Tender Form must be properly filled, otherwise the Tender Form will be rejected.
