The MRA invites young, dynamic, and qualified candidates to apply for enlistment as **Trainee Officer**.

Age Limit

Candidates should not be more than 30 years old by the closing date for submission of applications.

(The age limit for candidates already serving the MRA, shall be 35 years).

Qualifications

- A. Cambridge School Certificate or General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level" with at least five credits including English Language and Mathematics obtained on one certificate;
- B. A Cambridge Higher School Certificate or passes in at least two subjects obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education "Advanced Level", and
- C. A degree in Accounting, Finance, Business Studies, Economics, Law, Mathematics, Engineering or a relevant qualification acceptable to the MRA.

The selected candidate will:

1. be paid an all-inclusive allowance of Rs. 20,000 a month during the period of traineeship;
2. have to undergo an intensive 12-month in-house training programme on different taxes administered by MRA and other related matters. Progress will be monitored through continuous assessment, and a final written examination will be held at the end of the programme;
3. be considered for the post of '**Officer**' in one of the Departments of the MRA, after successful completion of the training and subject to vacancies being available *(The starting salary for the post of Officer is Rs. 49,300)*;
4. acquire an 'A' Level or equivalent in Accounting (in case of not possessing this presently), before being considered for the post of 'Officer'.
5. have to subscribe to a bond, in the sum of **Rs. 260,000** to, among other things, successfully complete the training course, and serve the MRA for a period of 3 years after appointment to the post of "**officer**".
