
CSG SCHOOL ALLOWANCE: Rs 2,000 MONTHLY TO CHILDREN AGED 3 TO 10 YEARS

As announced in the 2024/2025 Budget, a monthly **CSG School Allowance of Rs 2,000** will be paid by the Government of the Republic of Mauritius, for the months of July 2024 to June 2025, to children who have reached the age of three years up to the month in which they reach the age of ten years. The Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) has been entrusted with the responsibility to pay the allowance.

MRA informs parents of eligible children that the facility to apply for the payment of the monthly CSG School Allowance is available on MRA website www.mra.mu

Eligible Child

To benefit from the allowance, the child should:

- (i) be a citizen of Mauritius;
- (ii) be a resident in Mauritius in accordance with section 73(1)(a) of the Income Tax Act; and
- (iii) have reached the age of 3 years and have not reached the age of 10 years as at 1 July 2024.

Eligible Parent

Eligible parent refer to:

- (i) the mother;
- (ii) the father; or
- (iii) the person to whom a Court of competent jurisdiction has entrusted the guardianship of the eligible child.

The eligible parent is required to provide the bank details of the child held solely in his own name or held jointly with the eligible parent. MRA will make payment of the allowance solely in that bank account.

Where an eligible parent has more than one eligible child, separate applications should be made for each child.
