

## GOVERNMENT SUBSIDY ON ESSENTIAL GOODS (GSOG)

### Phase 2 – Pharmaceutical Products

Further to our Communiqué dated 07 January 2026 on the extension of Subsidy on Essential Goods and the subsequent Communiqué, dated 13 January 2026, issued by the Ministry of Commerce and Consumer Protection, the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) wishes to inform all Economic Operators that the coming into operation of the subsidy under the Price Stabilization Programme for **pharmaceutical products** has been postponed to **01 February 2026**. The list is given in the table below.

1	Anti-diabetic Medicines	Per box	50	Rs 100
2	Anti-Hypertensive Medicines	Per box	50	
3	Cardiovascular Medicines	Per box	50	

All economic operators dealing in these products are requested to register for the programme and the facility is available on the MRA website [www.mra.mu](http://www.mra.mu). To access the system, you will have to use either your National Identity Card (NID), Business Registration Number (BRN) or Tax Account Number (TAN) and your Mobile Number.

Thereafter, within 1 week of the coming into operation of the subsidized prices on 01 February 2026, Registered Economic Operators will be required to submit to the MRA, a declaration of stock as at that date. The necessary facilities will be available on the MRA website in due course.

Monthly Return declaring the sale of subsidized commodities will have to be submitted to the MRA. Subsequently, after verification, MRA will credit the amount of subsidy payable directly to the bank account of the Economic Operator.
