

COMMUNIQUE

SALE OF ABANDONED/UNCLAIMED GOODS BY PUBLIC TENDER QUOTATION NO. QUO202035

- 1. The public is hereby informed that the MRA is holding a sale of abandoned / unclaimed goods by public tender on its Online Auction System from **16 December to 23 December 2020**.
- 2. Prospective bidders, other than those already registered, have to register themselves on the Online Auction System by accessing the **e-Auction Sales link** on MRA's Website <u>www.mra.mu</u>.
- The item for sale, which is a used motor vehicle, will be posted on the Online Auction System for bidding under Quotation No. QUO202035 on Wednesday 16 December 2020 as from 09.00 hrs. The bidding will <u>close on</u> Wednesday 23 December 2020 at 12.00 hrs.
- 4. The vehicle has never been registered in Mauritius. The successful bidder will have to register his vehicle with the Registrar General in accordance with the Registration Duty Act at his own cost.
- 5. The motor vehicle shall be displayed at the Customs Warehouse, Lux Shed, Mer Rouge and can be viewed on the following dates and time:
 - Wednesday 16 December to Friday 18 December 2020 from 09.00 hrs to 15.45 hrs
 - Saturday 19 December 2020 from 09.30 hrs to 12.00 hrs
 - Monday 21 December and Tuesday 22 December 2020 from 09.00 hrs to 15.45 hrs
 - Wednesday 23 December 2020 from 09.00 hrs to 12.00 hrs
- 6. All bids on items which require a deposit shall be accompanied by a deposit representing at least 10% of the tender offer. Deposit should be made by way of **banker's cheque** drawn in favour of the Director-General, MRA, and deposited in a special tender box that will be placed at the Customs Warehouse, Mer Rouge <u>before the closure of the bidding.</u> The cheque should be placed in an envelope mentioning the name of the bidder and the items the deposit is intended to. Personal cheques will not be accepted.
- 7. Three bidding booths, with computer terminals, will be available at the Customs Warehouse, Mer Rouge for those who do not have access to internet facility.
- 8. Visitors are requested to bring along their Identity Cards for access at the Port Main Gate.
