MRA SEIZES 63 GRAMS OF METHAMPHETAMINE (MDMA) AND 6 GRAMS OF CANNABIS AT THE PARCEL POST OFFICE



The Customs Anti-Narcotics Section (CANS) of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) seized 63 grams of Methamphetamine (MDMA) worth around Rs 950,000, and 6 grams of cannabis, in two unclaimed parcels at the Parcel Post Office on Wednesday, 18 August 2021.

Upon examination of the parcels addressed to two individuals, residing at Mahebourg and Tamarin, respectively, CANS officers secured a substance suspected to be Methamphetamine (MDMA) from the first parcel, and a certain quantity of leaf, matter suspected to be Cannabis, from the second parcel.

MRA Customs Narcotics Sniffer Dog 'Oasis' reacted positively to the substances.

The case has been referred to ADSU for enquiry.
