(The Environment Protection Act - Section 66)

To be filled by a Manager of the enterprise/establishment being a hotel/guest house/ tourist residence and forwarded to the Director-General, Mauritius Revenue Authority, together with a remittance of the fee payable in respect of its accounting period (plus any penalty and interest) within 4 months after the end of the accounting period, provided its profit before tax but after deduction of the fee exceeds 5% of its turnover for the accounting period.
