### Notice to Stakeholders and Declarants

(1) Stakeholders and declarants are hereby informed that the current procedures relating to the warehousing of goods under the suspended duty regime in Freeport Zones as per section 7(3)(a)(i)(b) of the Freeport Act 2004 are being reviewed and new procedures will apply as per policy guidelines issued by the board of investment on 12.04.12. the policy guidelines may be accessed on the MRA website (<http://www.mra.mu>) or [click here to download](#).

In this context, existing CPCs as per table 1 will be de-activated on 01.07.2012 and replaced by new CPCs as per table 2

70FPL	IMPORT INTO FREEPORT BY A PERMIT HOLDER FOR STORAGE. MID LEVY
70FRA	IMPORT INTO FREEPORT BY A PERMIT HOLDER UNDER SUSPENDED DUTY FROM AIPORT
70FRL	IMPORT INTO FREEPORT BY PERMIT HOLDER SUSPENDED DUTY FROM AIRPORT/MID LEVY
70FRP	IMPORT INTO FREEPORT BY A PERMIT HOLDER FOR STORAGE

CPC	DESCRIPTION
70SDR	IMPORT INTO FREEPORT UNDER SUSPENDED DUTY REGIME BY A HOLDER OF STORAGE PERMIT ISSUED BY THE BOI
70SDL	IMPORT INTO FREEPORT UNDER SUSPENDED DUTY REGIME BY A HOLDER OF STORAGE PERMIT ISSUED BY THE BOI/MID LEVY

(2) Stakeholders and declarants are also informed that for ex-warehousing operations from warehouses under suspended duty regime in the freeport , the same CPCs as ex-warehousing operations from bonded warehouses will apply.

(3) Stakeholders and declarants are further informed that all consignments imported under CPCs 70FRA, 70FRP, 70FPL and 70FRL prior to 01.07.2012 need to be removed/cleared, as appropriate, by latest on 31.10.2012.
