Classification of lorries and pick up type vehicles (Gross vehicle weight [GVW] not exceeding 5 tons) in heading 87.04

<u>Distinction between lorries and pick up type vehicles:</u>

Motor vehicles having gross vehicle weight (GVW) not exceeding 5 tons are considered as "lorries" if they meet the following criteria:

- (i) They have drop down side panels and tail gate; or
- (ii) Their engines are found under the front seats

However, motor vehicles are considered as pick up type vehicles if they are provided with the following features:

- (i) The engine is found under the nose of the vehicle **and**
- (ii) **ONLY** the tail gate can be dropped down

To clarify the term "power rating" as and when it appears in Chapter 87

In Chapter 87, the expression "power rating" has the meaning hereby assigned to it: "power rating" means the **power of the electric motor** of the vehicles under consideration.

Additional notes to clarify the term "containers of plastic" of Chapter 39

Plastic containers which are **NOT**, prima facie, being identifiable as intended for the storage or packing of foodstuff or non- foodstuff, are classifiable in heading 39.24, subheading 3924.90.99 as other household containers of plastic.

Additional notes to clarify the term "cups of plastic" of Chapter 39

The expression "cups" as mentioned under HS Codes 3923.10.13, 3923.10.93, 3924.10.12, 3924.10.92 as the case may be, include glasses and the like, with or without handles.
