SEIZURE OF CANNABIS RESIN AND METHAMPHETAMINE AT PARCEL POST OFFICE



The Customs Anti-Narcotics Section (CANS) of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) seized 95 grams of cannabis resin and 12.6 grams of Methamphetamine at the Parcel Post Office today, 04 March, 2020. The estimated value of the drugs, which were sent in two packets from the U.K., is Rs. 474,000. The packets were tagged for scanning by the CANS officers and the scanning images showed concealments.

As the packets remained unclaimed at the Parcel Post Office, same were examined by the CANS officers and the drugs were found. The case was handed over to the Anti-Drug and Smuggling Unit (ADSU) for further investigation.
