

MRA SEIZES CANNABIS AT SSR INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT



The Customs Anti-Narcotics Section (CANS) of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) seized 1.79 grams of cannabis worth around Rs 1,074, on Sunday, 09 January 2022 at SSR International Airport.

During a search operation by MRA CANS officers, 1.79 grams of cannabis was seized in the locker of a ramp agent at SSR International Airport.

The cannabis and ramp agent was handed over to ADSU for further enquiry.
