MRA hosts Customs Attachment Programme for Comoros and Madagascar



In line with its mission to continually reform tax administration and build up capacity for its staff as well as share its experience and know-how with other countries, the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) has collaborated with the IMF AFRITAC South Office to mount up a one-month attachment programme on Customs for Senior Officers from Comoros Customs Administration and Madagascar Customs Administration. The attachment starts on Monday 11th January 2016 and ends on 5th February 2016.

This regional cooperation project aims at exposing Comoros and Madagascar Customs officials to regional best practice in Customs administrations. They will, in turn, be expected to take a leading role in reform and modernisation initiatives in their respective countries. The topics to be covered during the attachment will cover Risk Management, Enforcement, Airport Operations, Post Clearance Audit, Cargo Examination and use of new technologies amongst others.
