

MRA SEIZES CANNABIS AT PARCEL POST OFFICE



The Customs Anti-Narcotics Section (CANS) of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) seized approximately 7.94 grams of leaf matter suspected to be cannabis worth around Rs 4,700, on Tuesday, 15 February 2022 at Rivière Du Rempart Post Office.

During the examination of one parcel consisted of 1 book and a black rectangular cosmetic box which in turn, contained a transparent resealable plastic sachet enclosing a quantity of crushed leaf matter suspected to be cannabis was found.

During a control delivery exercise, the recipient of the parcel containing the cannabis, aged 26 years old, was arrested by ADSU. Following a search of his residence, 150 cannabis seeds were secured. The enquiry is in progress.
