

MRA SEIZES CANNABIS

WORTH ABOVE RS 15M



The Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) seized 13.14 kg of a product suspected to be Cannabis worth Rs 15,768,000 on 20 November 2025 at the SSR International Airport from a British national who was intercepted while leaving customs through the green channel.

After completing customs formalities, the suspect was brought to the MRA Customs counter for a luggage examination. A total of twenty-four (24) transparent plastic sachets, each containing compressed dried leaf matter suspected to be Cannabis, were found.

The MRA CANS Officers secured the exhibits.

Police enquiry is in progress.
