HEROIN, CANNABIS, ECSTASY AND METH INTERCEPTED AT PPO



Drugs, evaluated at Rs. 900,000, in unclaimed envelops were seized on Thursday 28 March, 2019 at the Parcel Post Office (PPO) by officers of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) Customs Anti-Narcotics Section (CANS). The drugs were concealed in three different envelops and they were sent from the United Kingdom (U.K.), from South Africa and from Netherlands. The unclaimed envelops bore the names of individuals of Flic en Flac, Black River, Pereybere, Camp de Masque and Quatre Bornes and same were targeted by CANS officers.

The MRA narcotics sniffer dog 'Otto' was deployed on the envelops and it reacted positively to the drugs. Upon examination, the following drugs were secured from the envelops:

- 70 tablets of Ecstasy valued at Rs. 225,000
- 5 grams of Crystal Meth valued at Rs. 75,000
- 9 grams of Cannabis valued at Rs 5,400
- 97.4 grams of Cannabis Resin valued at Rs 292,200
- 20.4 grams of Heroin valued at Rs. 306,000.

A field test on the drugs was positive and the latter were handed over to the Anti-Drug and Smuggling Unit (ADSU) for further inquiry.
