CONDUCT OF A TIME RELEASE STUDY IN MAURITIUS

In order to further improve the ease of doing business and reduce dwell time for the clearance of import and export consignments, the MRA with the collaboration of economic operators involved in the supply chain, will be conducting a national TRS from 05 September to 09 October 2016. In this context, a workshop was conducted in April 2016 to build the capacity of economic operators for conducting this TRS.

The study will cover import and export consignments, both through air and sea. Import consignments will be covered from the time of landing to time of gate-out after clearance and export consignments from the time of submission of an export bill of entry until the goods are loaded on the exporting vessel.

The aim of the Study is to measure the average time taken for completing the different procedures through the supply chain. This will enable the identification of bottlenecks and the formulation of recommendations for corrective actions.

The results of the TRS will be published and same will also be used as a benchmark for future Time Release Studies.

The MRA thanks the public for their participation to this study and reiterates its commitment to enhance its services to better serve the country.
