MRA HOSTS TRAINING OF TRAINERS WORKSHOP

The Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) is presently hosting the 2nd World Customs Organisation (WCO) East and Southern Africa (ESA) Training of Trainers (ToT) Workshop at the Address Boutique Hotel, Tombeau Bay. The workshop is organized by the WCO with the support and collaboration of the MRA and the WCO Regional Capacity Building Office of the ESA. The training runs from Monday 26th to Friday 30th September 2016.

The workshop is a follow-up of the first ToT workshop held in March 2016 in South Africa and it aims at developing the skills and capacity of participants from the following countries: Zimbabwe, Swaziland, Botswana, Kenya, Seychelles, Lesotho, Madagascar, Uganda, South Africa and Mauritius. The workshop specifically trains the participants to become instructors in Risk Management, in face of the ever dynamic international trade environment and the increasing importance of Risk Management in modern Customs Administration.

The workshop was officially launched by Mr Vivekanand Ramburun, Director of Customs Department, in the presence Ms Hélène CAUX, WCO representative. The workshop is facilitated by resource persons from the ESA region, namely from Mauritius, South Africa, Swaziland and Zimbabwe.
