

## MRA Launches Tax Connect Initiative with Workshop for Manufacturing Cluster

The Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) officially launched its first **Tax Connect Initiative** on Tuesday 03 March 2026 with a half-day workshop for the members of the Mauritius Export Association (MEXA) in Port-Louis.

Held from 09:00 to 12:30, the session marked the formal engagement under a structured national programme designed to strengthen taxpayer partnership, enhance voluntary compliance, and build institutional trust across key economic clusters.

### Structured and Technical Engagement

The programme began with a Welcome Note by Mrs. Lilowtee Rajmun-Jooseery, Director of MEXA, who underscored the importance of continued collaboration between the MRA and the export community.

The technical sessions addressed key compliance and operational matters relevant to manufacturing sector:
